- A problematic solution that needed the most user support was being replaced by development
- Vladimir used the opportunity to gather a focus group of 90-100 users at an early stage of development (representatives of Fortune 500 companies that were going to use it)
- Vladimir worked with product managers, support, and development to change the solution based on several rounds of user feedback
- The result was decrease of support efforts by 20% (1.5 FTE)
